

Questions for John 3:1-7: Nicodemus, Mr. Insider.

1. Am I inquisitive enough to want to learn more about Jesus?
2. Do I intentionally seek to have an audience with Jesus one-on-one as did Nicodemus?
3. Why do you think Jesus was so "direct" with Nicodemus by telling him "you must be born again?"
4. What promises are given by Jesus about the results of being born again?
5. Are we ever scared to publicly witness to folks about our faith in God?

Questions for John 4:1-9: Samaritan woman, Ms. Outsider

1. Is Jesus risking His reputation by talking with this woman in public?
2. Have you ever risked your reputation by witnessing to?
3. How does one worship in SPIRIT + TRUTH?
4. Why did Jesus select this Samaritan woman with all her "baggage" to be the first person to whom He revealed His Messiahship? (v25-26)
5. What are you "thirsting" for most in life today?
6. How can that "thirst" be satisfied?

Extra Credit--How does the #7 play out in the scene with Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well?
