6-In 1 Timothy 3:1-10 and Titus 1:6-9, Paul outlines the traits for elders and deacons in the NT church. What are your thoughts about these traits and is it (1) easy to lead a congregation and (2) is it easy to follow that leadership? HINT: SPIRITUAL LEADERS NEED LOYAL FOLLOWERS

7-What are some ways the church can encourage young people to enter into full time ministry--service within God's church?

8-In your secular job, what are some ways you can be a spiritual leader?

9-Daily what will it require for believers to have an ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE?

10-Today's lesson ended with 2 serious warnings from Hebrews 13:7 & 13:17-Imitate those faithful leaders who no longer may be alive but who "talked the talk AND walked the walk" and spiritual leaders may "tremble" at the thought that they will be held accountable and responsible for the WELFARE OF THE CHURCH which they oversee. Am I responsible for my own spiritual welfare and are my spiritual leaders also responsible?---think collectively and individually
